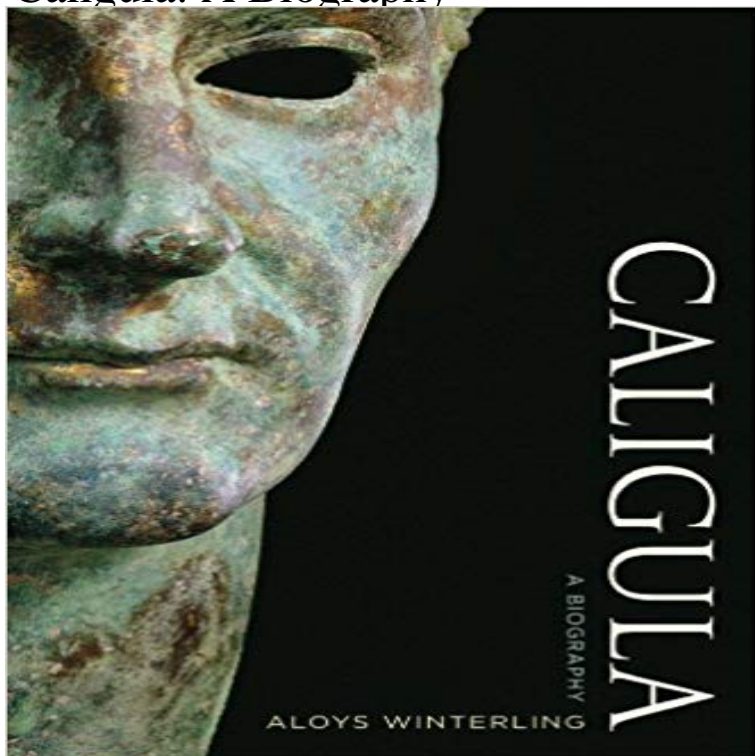


Caligula: A Biography
