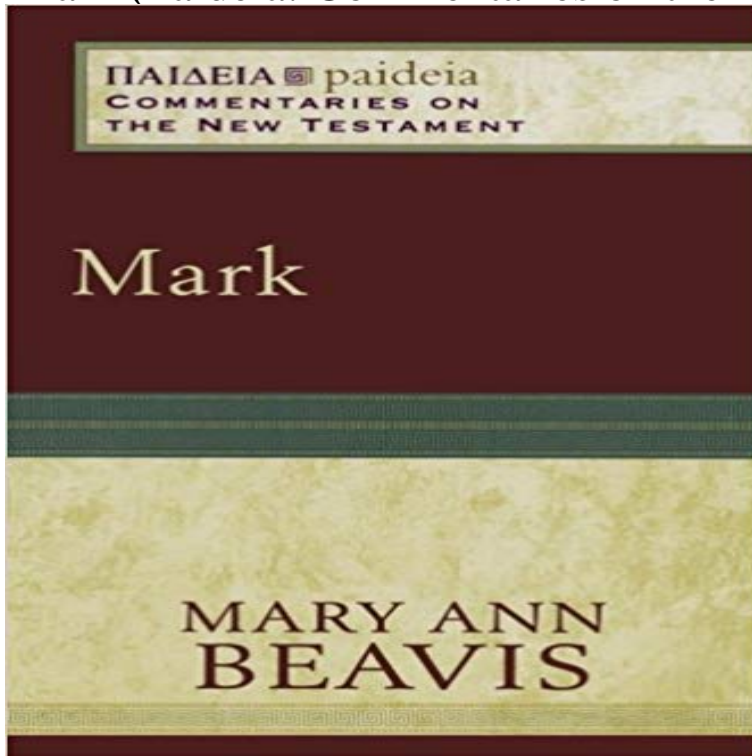


Mark (Paideia: Commentaries on the New Testament)
