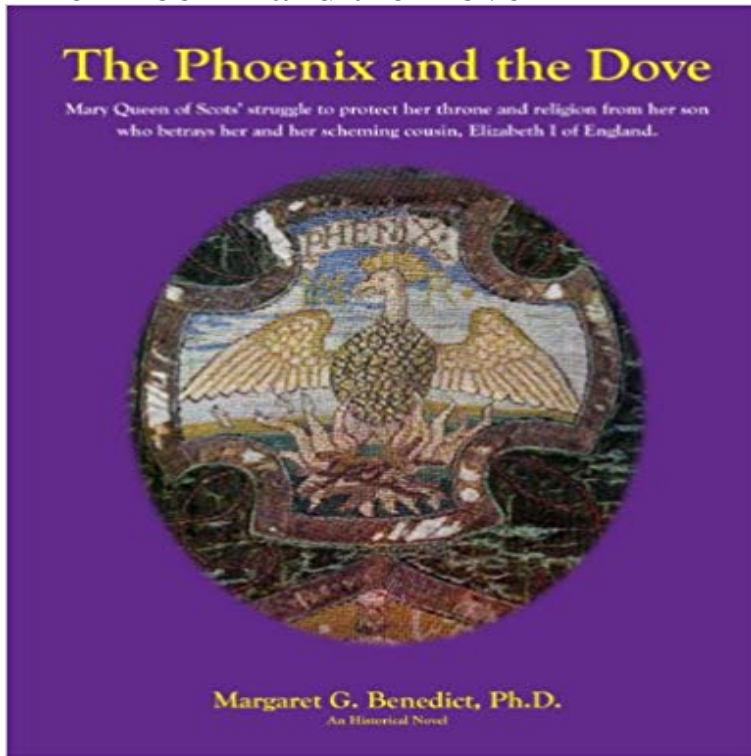


## The Phoenix and the Dove



What acts of treason and betrayal must a man commit to become King of England, France, Ireland and Scotland? The Phoenix and the Dove tells the story of a young King James VI who betrays his mother, the Catholic Mary Queen of Scots, to gain her kingdom. It is a story of Mary's battle against her bastard brother Moray and his Protestant confederates who murder her husband, King Darnley, and frame Mary for his murder. It is a story of religious strife as the Protestant majority in Parliament tries to eliminate Catholics in order to gain power. It is also a story of a young King James forbidden love for his male cousin which ultimately gives him the strength to overcome his oppressors, betray his mother and take control of his kingdom.

It is a story of rebirth, acceptance and tolerance of differences told from the point of view of Ariel Huntly, a naive young lord in Mary Queen of Scots court. The novel begins in March 1566 when Mary is six months pregnant with James VI. Mary struggles against Protestant lords to keep the crown for James. Ultimately, she fails and is incarcerated in England by her Protestant cousin, Elizabeth I. James is crowned King of Scotland while still in his cradle. He is baptized Catholic but is raised by Calvinist tutors who speak openly against his mother. The all male world inside Stirling castle is isolated and absent of human compassion. James is born with cerebral palsy; he cannot walk without assistance, even as an adult. His physical challenges are a secret to the outside world.

His Privy Council does not permit him to appear in public without another child, dressed in the same clothing, acting as a double for the small, clumsy, King. James' affliction makes him emotionally fragile, and he often chooses self gain at the expense of others. The only love James experiences is with his male cousin, Esme Stuart. The Calvinist Privy Council abhors the relationship, so they kidnap Esme and

send him back to France. James is devastated but he convinces himself that Esme will eventually return from exile and be reunited with his love.
