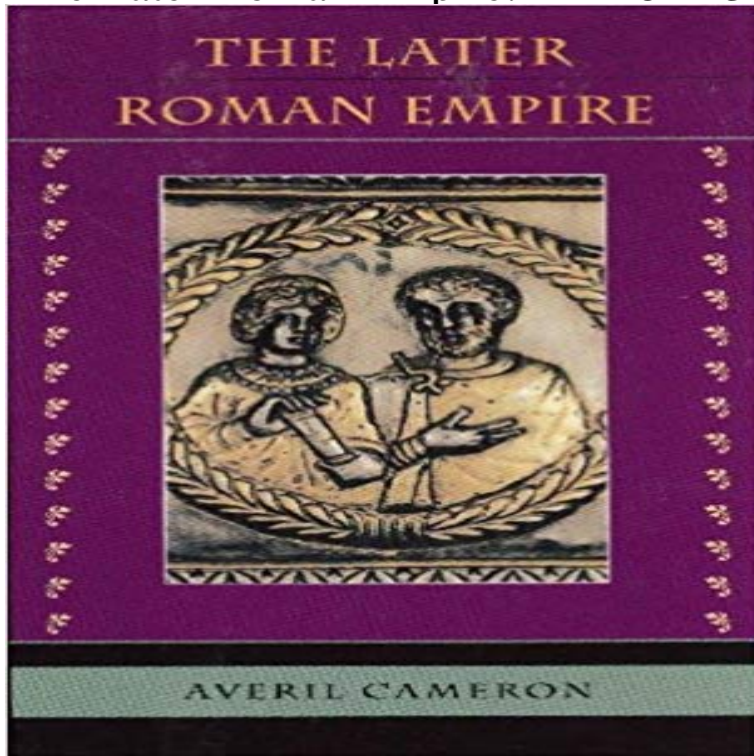


The Later Roman Empire: AD 284-430
