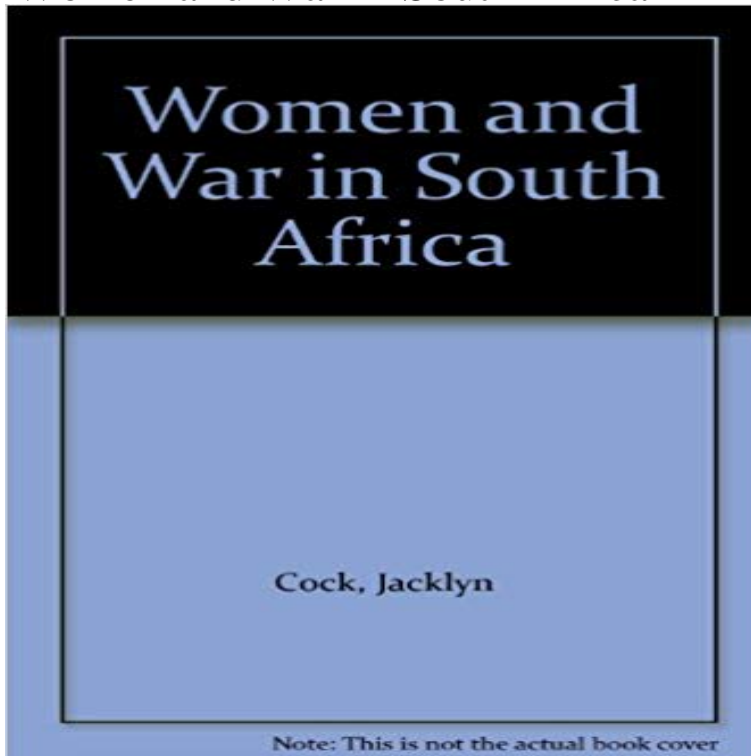


## Women and War in South Africa
