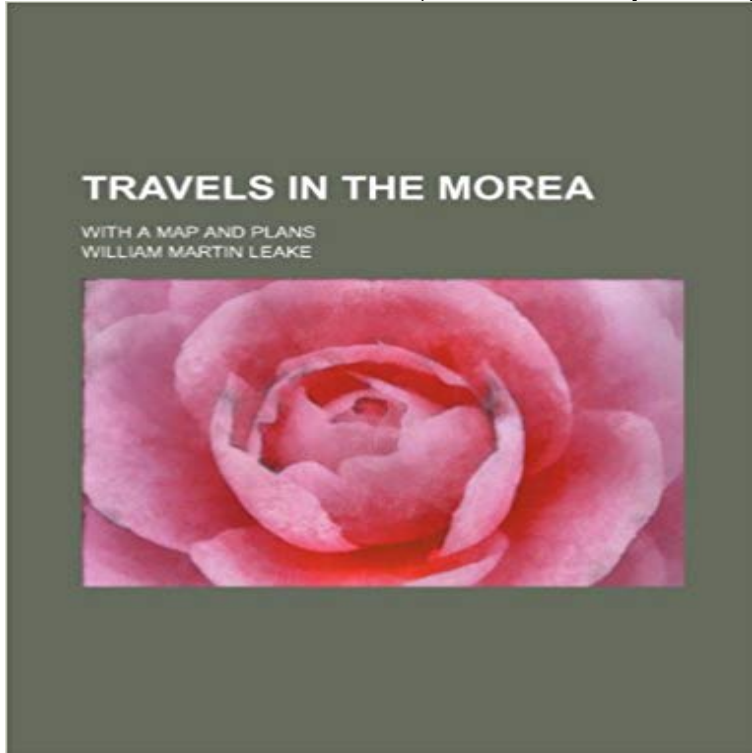


## Travels in the Morea; with a map and plans
